Work to Begin on US-77 North Wahoo Bypass

Weather permitting, work is scheduled to begin the week of November 4 on the US-77 North Wahoo Bypass in Saunders County, from Reference Post 92+93, west of the junction of US-77/N-92 north and west of Wahoo, to Reference Post 95+05, the junction of US-77/N-92 and N-109, according to the Nebraska Department of Roads.

Constructors, Inc. of Lincoln, Nebraska, has the \$13.1 million contract. Work will include grading, concrete paving, culverts, seeding, bridge, guardrail, electrical and general items. The anticipated completion date for this project is the spring of 2015.

New Traffic Signals Being Used at Gretna Interchange

The Nebraska Department of Roads will implement new traffic signals October 28 at the south ramp of the Gretna Interchange on I-80 (Exit 432). The replacement signals will be installed over the southbound left-turn lane and will use a flashing yellow arrow in place of the traditional circular green signal to indicate the need for left-turning vehicles to yield to oncoming traffic and pedestrians.

Use of the flashing yellow arrow has been shown to have several safety benefits, including minimizing traffic delays and enhancing safety by reducing driver errors. 

US-75 Improvements Planned South of Union

The Nebraska Department of Roads is planning a proposed US-75 improvement project south of Union in Otoe and Cass Counties. The project begins northwest of Nebraska City between County Roads “E” and “F”, where the pavement changes from concrete to asphalt, and extends north 6.11 miles ending south of the junction of US-75 and US-34 east of Union.

This segment was part of the designated detour route for I-29 traffic during the 2011 flooding. The high traffic volume during that detour accelerated the deterioration of the pavement and the bridges.

The improvements on this project would consist of completely removing the existing pavement and replacing it with new doweled concrete pavement on the main roadway and new surfacing on the shoulders. Drainage under the roadway would be improved. Bridges at the Union Pacific Railroad and at Weeping Water Creek will be rehabilitated.

The project is scheduled to begin in early spring of 2014 with completion in fall of the same year. Information regarding the proposed project may be found at the NDOR website:





Work to Begin on US-26 in Scottsbluff

Weather permitting, electrical work is scheduled to begin the week of November 4th on US-26 in the Scottsbluff area, according to the Nebraska Department of Roads (NDOR).

Mid-Plains Power, LLC. of Grand Island, Nebraska, has the \$130,296 contract. Work will consist of replacing outdated existing power cables with fiber optic cable, beginning at the intersection of US-26 and Overland Drive, and continuing along US-26 to the intersection at N-71 and Avenue I. The signal light controllers will be updated at the intersections of US-26 and 5th Avenue, and 27th Street and 21st Avenue.

Mid-Plains Power will start on the east end of the project and work west. Due to the nature of the project, traffic signals will be out of sequence for about three weeks while work is being performed. During daytime hours some traffic signals will not be in service and intersections will be controlled by four-way stop signs.

Access to local businesses will be maintained, while work at the intersection will be scheduled around peak hours to minimize inconvenience to the public. Work is anticipated to be completed by November 26.


