Work to Begin on N-27 in Chappell Area

Weather permitting, construction work is scheduled to begin March 16 on Nebraska Highway 27 (N-27) east of Chappell, according to the Nebraska Department of Roads.

Reiman Corp. and Subsidiary, of Cheyenne, Wyoming, is the prime contractor for the \$1.6 million project. Work includes bridge repair at the Oshkosh-Julesburg interchange bridge over I-80 at Reference Post 95+02 and the Walrath Bridge at Reference Post 100+31, four miles south of N-27 and the US-30 junction.

Traffic will be maintained at a reduced speed with lane closures in the work area. The bridges will be reduced to one lane with the use of concrete protection barriers and barricades. A 12-foot width restriction will be enforced on both bridges. The work is scheduled to be completed in the summer of 2015.

The Department of Roads' manager for the project is Russ Frickey of Bridgeport. Motorists are urged to use caution when driving through work zones and to remember that fines are doubled when workers are present.
