Construction on US Highway 6&34 in Holdrege

Work is scheduled to begin March 30, 2015, on a project to reconstruct a portion of Highway US-6/34 (Fourth Avenue) in Holdrege. The project, known as Garfield Street East begins just west of Garfield Street and extends 0.7 miles east on US-6/34. This portion of the highway will be closed to through traffic. A marked detour will be set up starting at the junction of US-6/34 & US-183 and ending at the intersection of US-6/34 & Brewster Road just east of Holdrege. The detour will utilize US-183 north to 18th Avenue, 18th Avenue east to Brewster Road and then Brewster Road back south to US-6 & 34. A temporary traffic signal will be set up at US-183 & 18th Avenue during the project to control traffic. Sherman Street will also remain open throughout the project. This work consists of grading, storm sewer, water main, street lighting and new 9" concrete pavement. It is anticipated the project will be completed by fall 2015. The prime contractor is Paulsen, Inc. of Cozad and the contract amount is \$3,459,835.95

A public information meeting for adjacent landowners and other concerned citizens will be held at 5:30 PM on Thursday, March 26, at the Nebraska Department of Roads (NDOR) office at 1013 West Fourth Avenue. Representatives of NDOR and the contractor will be on hand to explain the project and answer questions.
