Information Open House April 7 for N-14 and US-30 Improvements in Central City Area

The Nebraska Department of Roads will hold an Information Open House April 7 regarding the proposed improvement of Nebraska Highway 14 (N-14) and U.S. Highway 30 (US-30) in the Central City area in Hamilton and Merrick counties, known as **In Central City and South**. The open house will be held from 4:00-6:00 p.m. at the Central City Community Room, City Hall, 1515 17th St., in Central City.

The project would resurface approximately 3.69 miles and reconstruct 0.54 miles of N-14, starting 1.61 miles south of the junction of N-14 and Nebraska Highway 66 (N-66) and extending north of the junction of US-30 and N-14. This would include repair of the Platte River Bridge. In addition, the project would resurface approximately 0.5 miles of US-30 located in Merrick County, starting 0.24 miles west of the junction of US-30 and N-14, and extending approximately 0.26 miles east of the junction.

Personnel from the Department of Roads will be available to answer questions, receive comments, and discuss any aspect of the proposed highway improvement project. Information regarding the project will be available after the meeting on the NDOR website at
