Work to Begin on US-30, Wyoming State Line to Bushnell

Weather permitting, work is scheduled to begin the week of April 6 on US-30 from the Wyoming state line to Bushnell, according to the Nebraska Department of Roads.

Western Engineering Company, Inc. of Harlan, Iowa, has the \$3,253,911 contract for bridge deck repair, milling and resurfacing the lanes. The project will involve repair of the concrete bridge decks including sealing and waterproofing. Four inches of asphalt will be removed by cold milling and replaced with new asphaltic concrete. The project also includes the installation of rumble strips and new guardrail at both bridges.

Traffic will be maintained with the use of a pilot vehicle. There will be one-lane traffic at the bridges, controlled by yield signs, with a width restriction of 14 feet. Work is anticipated to be completed by July 10.

The Department of Roads' project manager is Jim Johnson of Gering. Motorists are reminded to drive cautiously through highway construction zones.
