Work to Resume on I-80, Hampton to Waco

Weather permitting, construction work is anticipated to resume Monday night, April 6, on I-80 from Hampton, Exit 332, to Waco, Exit 360, according to the Nebraska Department of Roads.

Werner Construction, Inc. of Hastings, Nebraska, has the \$13.3 million contract. Work will include bridge and pavement repairs, milling, asphalt overlay and culvert repair.

The majority of the work on this project is scheduled to be done between the hours of 7:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m., Sunday evening through Friday morning, with occasional work on Friday evening. Motorists can expect lane closures and reduced speeds.

Completion of the project is anticipated by mid-September. The Department of Roads' manager for this project is Jerry Grooms of York. Motorists are reminded to follow construction signs and to drive cautiously through highway work zones.
