Lincoln -- Six people successfully completed the April 3, 2015 examination and are now licensed by the Board of Examiners for County Highway and City Street Superintendents.

Licensed as City Street Superintendents are Michael E. Clark of Benkelman and Jim Shoup of Kimball.

Licensed as County Highway Superintendents are Brian Glos of North Platte, Megan Patent-Nygren of Ashland, Curtis Pokorny of Weston and Matthew Schardt of Table Rock.

Clark is Head of the City of Benkelman Street Department; Shoup is the City of Kimball Street Superintendent; Glos is a District 2 Subforeman for the Lincoln County Road Department; Patent-Nygren is a Training Program Coordinator for Nebraska Local Technical Assistance Program (LTAP) in Lincoln; Pokorny is a Senior Equipment Operator for the Lancaster County Engineering Department; and Schardt is the Johnson County Highway Superintendent.

- ◆ assisting in preparing annual budgets and financial reports,
- ◆ supervising the annual program for roadway design, construction and maintenance, and
- ◆ coordinating plans with adjacent counties and cities and with the Nebraska Department of Roads.
