Detour Scheduled for Railroad Work on US-30 East of Alda

Weather permitting, work is scheduled to start Friday, June 5, on US-30 east of Alda, according to the Nebraska Department of Roads.

Union Pacific Railroad will replace the crossings on US-30 just east of Alda. Highway traffic will be detoured using Husker Highway and Alda Road during the railroad repair work. US-30 is anticipated to be reopened to traffic Monday afternoon, June 8.

The Department of Roads' manager for this highway rail crossing repair work is Bob Nordhues of Grand Island. Motorists are reminded to drive cautiously and allow extra time due to the 3.5 mile detour.
