Work to Begin on US-30, Wood River to Grand Island

Weather permitting, work is scheduled to start the week of June 1, on US-30, Reference Post 300+28, east of Wood River, to Reference Post 312+47, just west of Grand Island, according to the Nebraska Department of Roads.

Vontz Paving, Inc., of Hastings, Nebraska, has the \$4.6 million contract to repair concrete, mill and resurface roadway and shoulders with asphaltic concrete. Traffic on this 12.13-mile highway improvement project will be controlled by one-lane work zones, a pilot car and flaggers. The project is anticipated to be completed in the fall of 2015.

The Department of Roads' manager for this highway improvement project is Bob Nordhues of Grand Island. Motorists are reminded to drive cautiously through the construction zones.
