Traffic Signal Removal Study Planned

The traffic signal at the intersection of 8th Avenue with US-183 in Holdrege has been identified for possible removal, according to the Nebraska Department of Roads (NDOR).

A department study has been performed at the intersection which indicates the signal may no longer be appropriate for existing traffic conditions. This signal was installed as a school crossing signal and the school has closed. As part of a traffic signal removal study, the NDOR will place the lights into flashing mode beginning June 15.

North-south traffic will not be required to stop, while eastbound traffic will be required to stop. The traffic study is expected to take six weeks to complete. The decision to remove the signal will be based on previous study results and public input received during the study. It is anticipated that the signals will be removed at the end of this study.
