## Work to Begin on N-64 from US-77 to the Platte River Near Leshara

Weather permitting, work is scheduled to begin the week of June 22 on N-64 from US-77 to the Platte River, including the Leshara Spur, S-78J, according to the Nebraska Department of Roads.

Western Engineering Company, Inc., Harlan, Iowa, has the \$1,977,670 contract for concrete pavement, an asphalt overlay on N-64 and S-78J, and bridge repair for the bridge located on S-78J. Traffic along N-64 will be reduced daily to a single lane and will be controlled by flaggers and the use of a pilot vehicle. Traffic along S-78J will also be reduced to a single lane and will include temporary traffic signals for the bridge repairs. Completion of this project is anticipated October 2015.

The Department of Roads' manager for this highway improvement project is Bob Traudt of Lincoln. Motorists are reminded to drive cautiously through the construction zones.
