I-80 Temporarily Closed West of Lincoln on June 15

Weather permitting, eastbound I-80 will be temporarily closed on June 15 between Milford Exit 382 and Lincoln Exit 401, according to the Nebraska Department of Roads. A detour will be in place to direct traffic north at Exit 382 to US-34, east on US-34, then back to I-80 at Exit 401.

Westbound I-80 will also be closed on June 15 between Pleasant Dale Exit 388 and Milford Exit 382. A detour will be in place to direct traffic south at Exit 388 to US-6, east on US-6 to L-80H and then north back to I-80 at Exit 382.

Both of these closures will begin at 10:00 p.m. and I-80 will be re-opened by 6:00 a.m. on Tuesday.

The work being performed is replacement of overhead Dynamic Message Boards. Watts Electric, of Waverly, Nebraska is the contractor for the \$92,103 project.

The Department of Roads' manager is Jesse De Los Santos of Lincoln. Motorists are reminded to drive cautiously through work zones, along detours and selected alternate routes.
