Railroad Crossing Repair East of Crete

Railroad crossing repair work is scheduled to begin the week of July 6, on N-103, Reference Post 46, on the east edge of Crete, according to the Nebraska Department of Roads. Work is anticipated to take three days.

Both lanes of traffic will be closed. Eastbound I-80 traffic use Exit 379 to N-15, south to US-6 to L-76E at Dorchester, then N-33 east to Crete. Westbound I-80 traffic use Exit 397, US-77 south to N-33 then to Crete.

The crossing repair work is being done by the Burlington Northern Santa Fe Railway. Motorists are asked to drive safely near construction work and along detour routes.
