Bridge Work to Begin on N-74 West of Ong Spur

Weather permitting, work is scheduled to begin the week of July 13 on the N-74 bridge 10 miles west of the Ong Spur, in Clay County, according to the Nebraska Department of Roads.

Wilke Contracting Corporation of Kearney, Nebraska, has the \$1,079,520 contract. Work includes new pilings on bridge approach areas, removing and replacing the deck, along with new rail and approach slabs, new guardrail and grading.

The bridge will remain open to traffic during construction, but will be reduced to one-lane traffic using a yield sign, with the eastbound lane closed first, followed by the westbound lane. Anticipated completion date is mid-November.

The Department of Roads' project manager is Tom Anderson of York. Motorists are reminded to drive cautiously through construction zones.
