Work to Begin on N-105 West of Humboldt

Weather permitting, work is scheduled to begin the week of July 27 on N-105 from the west junction of N-4, located at the Richardson/Pawnee county line, Reference Post 11+67, north to the junction of N-67, Reference Post 32+72, according to the Nebraska Department of Roads.

Constructors, Inc. of Lincoln, Nebraska, has the \$2,715,163 project, which consists of pavement repair and new asphalt overlay. During construction on this 20.2-mile project, traffic will be maintained by one-lane work zones with flaggers and pilot cars when necessary. The project is anticipated to be completed in the fall.

The Department of Roads' project manager is Bill Jasa of Tecumseh. Motorists are reminded to drive cautiously through work zones.
