Work to Begin on N-66, N-15 to Dwight Spur

Weather permitting, work is scheduled to begin the week of July 27 on N-66 from N-15 to the Dwight Spur, between Reference Posts 46+94 and 50+95, according to the Nebraska Department of Roads.

Constructors, Inc. of Lincoln, Nebraska, has the \$1,653,323 project, which consists of bridge rehabilitation, pavement repair and new asphalt overlay. During construction on this four-mile project, traffic will be maintained by one-lane work zones with flaggers and pilot cars when necessary. One bridge will be controlled by temporary traffic signals. The highway improvement project is anticipated to be completed in early October.

The Department of Roads' manager for this project is Craig Branch of Lincoln. Motorists are reminded to drive cautiously through construction zones at all times.
