Work to Begin on N-66, Dwight to N-79

Weather permitting, work is scheduled to begin the week of September 8 on N-66 from the Dwight spur to N-79, between Reference Posts 50+94 to 61+00, according to the Nebraska Department of Roads.

Constructors, Inc. of Lincoln, Nebraska, has the \$1,379,533 project, which consists of a new asphalt overlay. During construction on this ten-mile project, traffic will be maintained by one-lane work zones with flaggers and pilot cars when necessary. The highway improvement project is anticipated to be completed in late October.

The Department of Roads' manager for this project is Craig Branch of Lincoln. Motorists are reminded to drive cautiously through construction zones at all times.
