## Work to Begin on N-2 West of Cairo

Weather permitting, construction work is scheduled to begin the week of September 8 on N-2, starting west of the Buffalo/Hall County Line at Reference Post 337+49, and ending just west of Cairo at Reference Post 343+00, according to the Nebraska Department of Roads.

Vontz Paving, Inc., of Hastings, Nebraska, has the \$1.6 million contract, which consists of concrete bridge repairs, milling and resurfacing the roadway and shoulders with asphaltic concrete. During construction of this 5.51-mile highway improvement project, traffic will be controlled by one-lane work zones, a pilot car and flaggers. The project is anticipated to be completed in the spring of 2016.

The Department of Roads' manager for this highway improvement project is Bob Nordhues of Grand Island. Motorists are reminded to drive cautiously through the construction zones.
