Vision

The overall vision for Vision 2032 is to “Provide Direction for Nebraska’s Transportation Future.”

Project Overview

Vision 2032 will be an overarching policy guide that establishes the goals, objectives and the strategies to address the core challenges and opportunities facing Nebraska over the next 20 years. Vision 2032 will provide an inventory of all transportation modes and address the need for improvements to the following:

- Nebraska Highway and Road Network
- Public Transportation
- Bicycle and Pedestrian Pathways
- Movement of Freight
- Marine
- Aviation
- Intelligent Transportation Systems

The analysis will help Nebraska plan for improved connectivity between modes and between communities. It will also enable our multimodal system to operate more efficiently. We want and need the public's perspectives and suggestions to guide future decisions. The Statewide Long Range Transportation Plan will encompass a 20-year period (2012-2032) and will:

- Analyze the existing transportation system including:
 - A description/inventory of existing systems and conditions
 - A description of current needs and issues
 - A description of existing funding sources
- Analyze the future needs and project future funding
- Address the eight planning factors required by 23 USC § 135 (d)(1) ~see page 15
- Provide direction (via goals, objectives, and strategies) to address Nebraska’s transportation priorities and challenges
