## Information Open House November 19 for Improvements on US-30 in Kearney

The Nebraska Department of Roads will hold an Information Open House November 19 regarding the proposed improvement of U.S. Highway 30 (US-30), in Buffalo County, known as **12<sup>th</sup> – 7<sup>th</sup> Ave., Kearney**. The open house will be held from 4:00-6:00 p.m. at the Kearney Public Library, 2020 1<sup>st</sup> Ave., in Kearney.

The proposed project would address the need of reducing the rate, frequency and severity of crashes on this segment of US-30 in Kearney between 12<sup>th</sup> Avenue and 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue. Proposed improvements would consist of safety mitigations and intersection improvements.

The project may consist of pavement modifications that would require removing portions of the existing pavement cross section of concrete and building new concrete pavement. The project would also include replacement or installation of storm sewer, underdrains, sidewalks, curb ramps, lighting, traffic signals and permanent pavement markings.

The proposed project is currently in the 5-year Nebraska Surface Transportation Program. The project is anticipated to be completed within one construction season.

Personnel from the Department of Roads will be available to answer questions, receive comments, and discuss any aspect of the proposed highway improvement project. Information regarding the project will be available after the meeting on the NDOR website at
