Work to Begin on US-281, South of Greeley

Weather permitting, work is scheduled to begin the week of April 11 on US-281, south of Greeley, according to the Nebraska Department of Roads.

Werner Construction, Inc. of Hastings, Nebraska, has the \$5,144,813 contract for grading, lengthening of culverts, milling and widening the roadway to 28 feet, with rumble strips on the outside edges. This work runs from the east junction of US-281/N-22 (Wolbach Corner) to the west junction of US-281/N-22 (Scotia Corner).

Traffic will be maintained with flaggers and there will be two areas of one-lane traffic controlled by temporary traffic signals. There will be a 10-foot width restriction for the driving lanes. The project is anticipated to be completed by October.

The Department of Roads' manager for this project is Jerry Woodgate of St. Paul. Motorists are urged to use caution when driving through construction zones.
