Work to Begin on US-30 West of Kearney

Weather permitting, work is scheduled to start the week of May 23 on US-30, from Reference Post 267+44, three miles west of Kearney, to Reference Post 270+63, on the west edge of Kearney, according to the Nebraska Department of Roads.

Werner Construction, Inc. of Hastings, Nebraska, has the \$1.6 million construction contract for concrete repair, culvert extensions, and widening for a left-turn lane at the intersections of US-30, Cotton Mill Ave., and 62nd Ave. Work will also include milling and resurfacing the roadway and shoulders with asphaltic concrete.

Traffic on this 3.2-mile highway improvement project will be controlled by one-lane work zones, a pilot car and flaggers. The project is expected to be completed in late summer.

The Department of Roads' manager is Bob Nordhues of Grand Island. Motorists are reminded to drive cautiously through the construction zones.
