Work to Begin on US-77, Pickrell Spur North to East Junction of N-41

Weather permitting, work is scheduled to begin on the week of July 5 on the northbound and southbound lanes of US-77 from the Pickrell Spur north to the east junction of N-41, according to the Nebraska Department of Roads.

Ten Point Construction Co., of Denison, Iowa has the contract for the \$769,000 project, which includes concrete pavement repairs. Motorists can expect lane closures, reduced speed and a 14-foot width restriction. The project is anticipated to be completed by late fall.

The Department of Roads' project manager for this project is Dennis Endorf of Fairbury. Motorists are reminded to drive cautiously through construction zones.
