Work to Begin on N-14 in Central City Area

Weather permitting, work is scheduled to begin the week of July 25 on N-14 from the intersection of Reyner Road, which is 3.5 miles south of Central City, to the intersection of 25th Street in Central City, according to the Nebraska Department of Roads.

Vontz Paving, Inc., of Hastings, Nebraska, has the \$3,430,686 contract. Work on the entire highway improvement project will include concrete pavement repair, bridge repair, asphalt overlay and shoulders, earth shouldering, seeding, rumble strips, sidewalk repair and minor storm sewer and electrical work. Work done in 2016 will include concrete pavement repair and bridge repair. Work done in 2017 will include asphalt overlay and shoulder, earth shouldering, seeding, rumble strips, sidewalk repair and minor storm sewer and electrical work. The entire project is anticipated to be completed in the spring of 2017.

Traffic will be maintained at all times during the project and will be controlled using temporary traffic signals, flaggers and pilot vehicles. A 12-foot width restriction will be in place.

The Department of Roads' manager for this highway improvement project is Ben Merchant of Grand Island. Motorists are asked to drive cautiously through the work zone and to expect some delays.
