## Work to Begin on US-77/N-92 in Wahoo

Weather permitting, work is scheduled to begin the week of August 8 on north US-77 in Wahoo from North Broadway Street to the N-92 and N-109 junction, according to the Nebraska Department of Roads.

Oldcastle Materials Midwest Co., DBA Omni Engineering of Omaha, Nebraska, has been awarded the \$714,109 contract. Work on this 1.6-mile project includes pavement repair, milling and an asphalt overlay.

During construction, daily lane closures controlled with flaggers and a pilot vehicle will be required from dawn to dusk. Motorists can expect delays and are encouraged to seek alternate routes. Daily closures to some of the urban intersections within the town of Wahoo that intersect US-77 may also be required. The highway improvement project is anticipated to be completed in the fall.

The Department of Roads' project manager is Bob Traudt of Lincoln. Motorists are urged to use caution when driving through construction zones and along alternate routes.
