Public Information Open House Meeting

The Nebraska Department of Roads (NDOR) will hold a public information open house regarding a proposed improvement of Nebraska Link 10C (L-10C) in Buffalo County. The meeting will be held at the Gibbon Public Library, 116 LaBarre Street in Gibbon on Monday, October 17th from 4:00 to 6:00 P.M.

Identified as ***Gibbon Link***, the proposed project would resurface 2.73 miles of L-10C, starting approximately 300 feet south of the southern Interstate 80 (I-80) interchange ramps at mile marker (MM) 0.00, and extending north to MM 2.80, just south of 10th Street, where the pavement changes from asphalt to concrete. The project would also include shoulder widening, culvert replacement and extensions, and repair of the bridge over I-80. Construction may begin and/or end approximately 200 feet ahead of or beyond the actual project limits to accommodate transitioning the pavement.

The purpose of the proposed project is to preserve the transportation asset, improve the reliability of the transportation system, and perpetuate the mobility of the traveling public. The need for the project is based on the condition of the current roadway, bridge structure, and culverts.

The planned construction would consist of milling and resurfacing the roadway with asphalt. Shoulders would be widened, and new ditches would be constructed. Intersections and driveways would be reconstructed. The bridge over I-80, Structure S080 28566, would be repaired. Culverts would be repaired, extended, and/or replaced as warranted.

The project would require the acquisition of additional property rights for construction throughout the project area, including new right-of-way and temporary easements. Impacts to the Windmill State Recreation Area are anticipated due to the proposed acquisition of new right-of-way from the park. The proposed right-of-way would be used for the construction of new roadway ditches to accommodate the widened shoulders and would not interfere with the amenities of the park. Impacts to wetlands are anticipated and would be mitigated at a U.S. Army Corps of Engineers approved wetlands mitigation bank.

Construction is tentatively scheduled to begin summer of 2018 with completion in the winter of 2018. The project would be constructed under traffic with lane closures controlled with approved temporary traffic control. Access to adjacent properties would be maintained during construction but may be limited at times due to phasing requirements.


This public open house meeting is being held to provide information regarding the project and to receive the public's input. All interested persons are invited to attend and present relevant comments and questions. Design information will be displayed and personnel from NDOR will be present to answer questions and receive comments. The information "open house" format allows the public to come at any time during the advertised hours, gather pertinent information about the project, speak one-on-one with project personnel and leave as they wish. A formal presentation will not be included as part of this information open house.

NDOR will make every reasonable accommodation to provide an accessible meeting facility for all persons. Appropriate provisions for the hearing and visually challenged or persons with Limited English Proficiency (LEP) will be made if the Department is notified by October 7, 2016. The public is being encouraged to make suggestions or express concerns regarding this proposed project. Comments will be collected through November 2, 2016.
