On Friday, June 23, 2023, the Nebraska State Highway Commission convened at Ainsworth Conference Center located at 606 E 4th St in Ainsworth, Nebraska. Vicki Kramer, NDOT Director

- Legislative Update
 - NDOT Budget Approved

•

- \$100M Addition to support the IIJA
- \$33M/Year
 - Cap of gas tax at \$.29
- o LB 706 & LB 727
 - Bills were combined. The Commission does have a role in bonding approval. The bonging option would only be utilized on the right projects, would be an innovative approach.
 - There is an education piece that would be needed internal and externally
- LB 683 Broadband
 - The approval of the bill moves the Broadband Office into NDOT which will ultimately support the Broadband Office with incoming BEAD Funds. The BEAD funds come from IIJA Funds, which NDOT has skills to support Federal Funding.
 - Once of three active programs, unique guidelines, and requirements for fund deployment.
 - Official Allocation is anticipated in one week. Once this is identified there is a 180-day clock that begins on identifying a 5-year plan for deploying funds.
- Transportation Summit
 - IIJA is a complex bill, so NDOT is hosting a local workshop on August 23rd to support our local partners in identifying grant opportunities that are available and what they need to do to better position themselves to obtain those funding opportunities.
- o Governor's Economic Development Summit
 - This is to be held on August 9th. The debut of the new broadband fiber map will occur here. NDOT will participate on three panels, Broadband, Workforce Development, and Freight Planning/Intermodal Transportation.

- Welcome everyone in attendance. The purpose of holding these meetings in the districts is to get us out, see projects in the area and talk to the locals.
- District Presentation
 - Mark Kovar, NDOT District 8 Engineer
 - District 8 consist of 9 counties.
 - o 2023 Winter Operations

- \$3.7M was spending snow and ice removal in 2023.
- District Maintenance Staff did a great job clearing the snow as quickly as they did given the amount of snow that fell.
- There was local concern about the new Niobrara River Bridge near Spencer as the bridge does sit low. The bridge was designed to withstand these kinds of weather conditions and it did quite well.
- Current Highway Improvement Projects to note:
 - In Ainsworth
 - Urban Reconstruction
 - In Valentine
 - Urban Reconstruction. Once completed, another reconstruction project will begin on W 4th St.
 - Stafford Holt/Antelope Co. Line
 - Long awaited, 8-mile Resurfacing project
- Future Highway Improvement Projects
 - Hwy 7 In Ainsworth
 - Reconstruction Project includes a detour. Currently scheduled for Dec 2023 Letting, spring 2024 construction
 - In Butte & North
 - Resurfacing and widening project. Currently scheduled for October 2023 letting, spring 2024 construction
 - Long Pine Bridge
 - Bridge Replacement requiring a long detour. Currently scheduled to let August 2023, spring 2024 construction
 - W 4th St., Valentine
 - Reconstruction project requiring a detour on city streets. Currently scheduled for December 2023, spring 2024 construction.
